Second: The **Wheatland Airport (KEAN) Grand Opening** of their new runway is set for **August 29**, see attached poster for details.

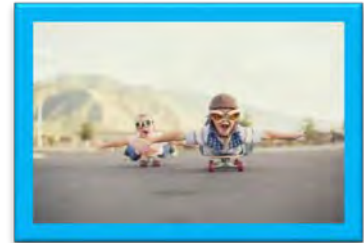
=>They are looking for people to help with mustering planes to parking, if interested please contact Arnie Minear at arnie@wyomingwireless.com (see flyer)

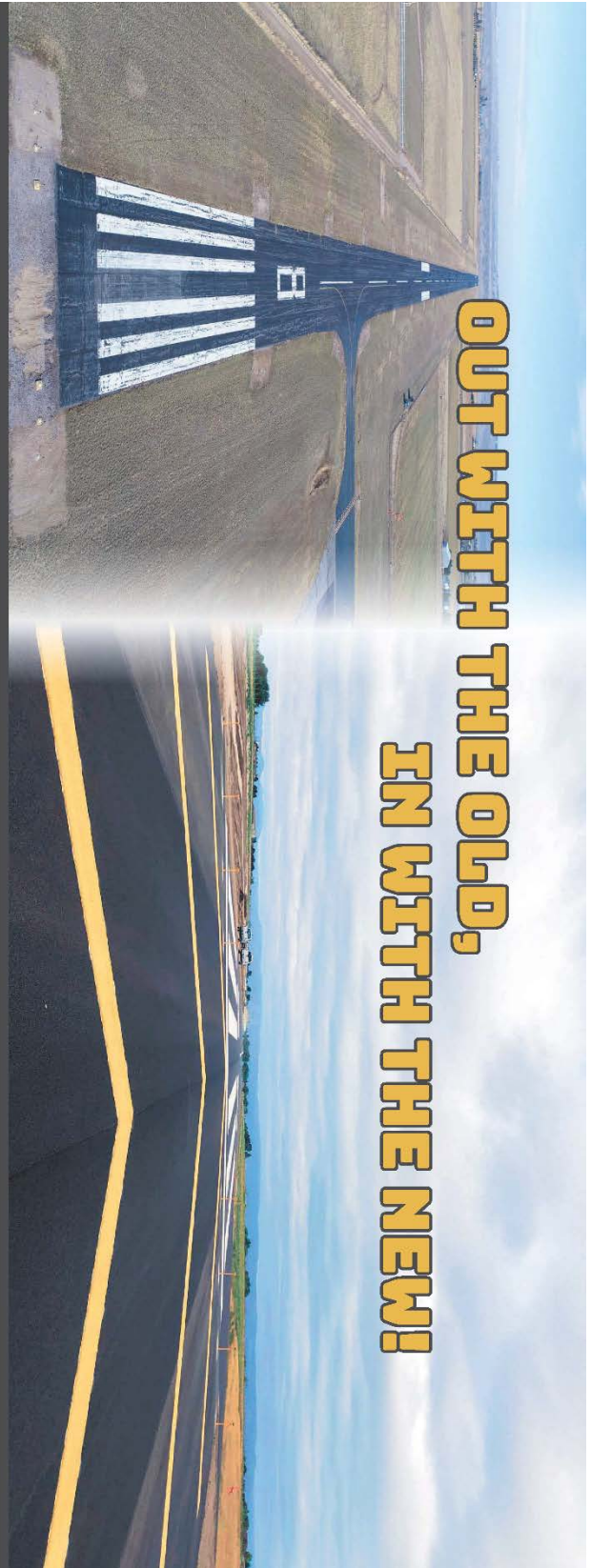

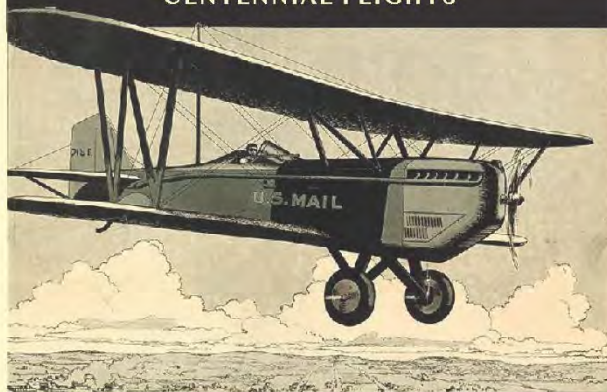
